

- **Doubles the amount of the homestead exemption** for city and county property taxes
- **Exempts the first \$25,000** in equipment owned by businesses from tangible personal property taxes
- **Provides portability for Save Our Homes benefits** - Up to \$500,000 of accrued Save Our Homes benefits can be transferred by those buying a new homestead
- **Limits the amount** that an assessment on non-homestead property can be increased to 10% - This would apply to commercial property, rental housing and second homes
