

5) Attached are copies of documents that the People currently intend to use at trial. Those documents are:


- 1) EDC Support Corp "Hardware Options" sheet dated August 10, 1994, listing the price of a Dell computer system as \$4,874.15;

PEOPLE'S MOTION FOR PRE-TRIAL DISCOVERY  
PURSUANT TO ILLINOIS SUPREME COURT RULES 413 AND 415

NOW COME the People of the State of Illinois, by JAMES E. RYAN, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, through his assistant, Cliff C. Histed, and move this Honorable Court, pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rules 413(c), 413(d), and 415(b) to enter an Order directing defendant and his attorney or attorneys:

1. To give written notice to the People of the State of Illinois of any defenses, affirmative or non-affirmative, which the defendant intends to assert at any hearing or at trial. If the defendant intends to assert the defense of Alibi he shall state in writing his location at the time of the alleged offense and the identity of witnesses to such alibi defense as in "2" below. Having notice of such defense, the People will furnish prior to trial the names and addresses of any additional witnesses to be called to rebut said alibi defense. Rule 413(d).
2. To furnish in writing to the People of the State of Illinois the names and last known addresses of persons the defendant intends to call as witnesses, together with their relevant written or record statements, including memoranda reporting or summarizing their oral statements, and any record of prior criminal convictions of such witnesses known to the defendant or his attorneys. Rule 413(d).
3. To inform the People of the State of Illinois, and to permit the inspection and copying or photographing of any reports, results or testimony relative thereto, of physical or mental examinations or of scientific tests, experiments, or comparisons, and any other reports of statements of experts which defense counsel has in his possession or control, including, but not limited to, statements made by the defendant contained in reports, any part of which defense counsel intends to use at a hearing or trial. Rule 413(c).



9. Work at a lawful occupation, and/or further your education, and support your dependents.
10. Refrain from possessing a firearm or other dangerous weapon.
11. Pay a Probation fee of \$25.00 or \$ \_\_\_\_\_ each month.
12. Pay all costs, fees, fines and restitution in full not less than 60 days before the end of probation in equal monthly installments.
13. Promptly undertake urinalysis testing, and evaluations (including but not limited to substance abuse and psychological) as determined appropriate by the Probation Department and thereafter complete such treatment, therapy, counseling and/or remedial education as ordered by the Probation Department. Refusal to participate, or withdrawal or discharge from any of the above programs, will be considered a violation of Probation and will be reported to the Court.
