**The following significant information was gathered for the Exemption Review:**

According to a copy of a school access card, Mr. Marshall passed a Level II screening by the Pinellas County School Board on 09/03/2005. Mr. Marshall began working for the City of St. Petersburg's Parks and Recreation Department in 1998. The Parks Director, Clifford Footlick, reported that they were aware of his disqualifying offense and allowed him to work because it had been longer than three years since that arrest.

[REDACTED] According to court documents that were provided by Mr. Marshall, he unlawfully entered [REDACTED]. When Mr. Marshall was apprehended, he had a [REDACTED]. Mr. Marshall was sentenced to probation, 30 days in the county jail and court costs.

[REDACTED] According to the "Arrest Affidavit" from the [REDACTED] County Sheriff's Office, Mr. Marshall [REDACTED]. Mr. Marshall admitted to [REDACTED] his Miranda rights. Mr. Marshall pled guilty and was sentenced to 90 days in jail.

[REDACTED] According to the "Arrest Affidavit", Mr. Marshall was operating a vehicle that was [REDACTED]. When police pulled him over, [REDACTED]. This arrest occurred on a Wednesday at noon. Mr. Marshall pled nolo Contendre and was adjudicated guilty.

[REDACTED] According to the "Arrest Affidavit", Mr. Marshall [REDACTED]. Mr. Marshall [REDACTED]. This arrest occurred on Thursday at 6:42 pm. Mr. Marshall pled nolo Contendre and was adjudicated guilty.

Both of Mr. Marshall's [REDACTED] occurred in [REDACTED] County, though he resided in Hillsborough County.

**Applicant's version of the disqualifying incident:**

Mr. Marshall does not deny the accounts that are listed above for any of his arrests. He stated during his exemption review that he was [REDACTED]. Mr. Marshall stated that he was [REDACTED]. This would mean that he began [REDACTED]. He stated that he was [REDACTED]. Mr. Marshall stated that he was "relieved" when he saw the police cars lights in his rearview mirror because he did not believe that he could stop on his own.

**Current status with court system/probation:**

Mr. Marshall provided paperwork showing that he completed probation in August of 2004.

**Degree of harm to any victim, any permanent or temporary damage or injuries:**

There were no damages that we noted for Mr. Marshall's disqualifying offense or the other arrests that we have reports on.

**Stressors in the applicant's life at the time of disqualifying incident and whether they are still present:**

**Current Stressors, current support system, current living arrangements:**

Mr. Marshall stated that [REDACTED] friends, family and kids that he worked with are his support system.

**Work history for last 3 years:**

Mr. Marshall has worked at both Pathfinders Outdoor Education and Boyd Hill Camp since 1998. These programs are under the City of St. Petersburg's Parks and Recreation Department. There are several letters from Mr. Marshall's employer that support him. During his exemption review, Debi Lanning and Mr. Marshall divulged that Mr. Marshall was suspended for 6 months by "Pathfinders Outdoor Education" in October 2006. Mr. Marshall served 2 months of that suspension and was reinstated December 1, 2006. [REDACTED] Ms. Lanning and Mr. Dock were the only people present that stated they were aware of Mr. Marshall [REDACTED]

**Education/training:**

Mr. Marshall stated that he graduated from Boca Ciega high school in 1971. He is a certified Red Cross Life Guard and has completed his CPR requirements.

**Counseling received:**

Mr. Marshall was court ordered to and completed [REDACTED] the Family Center of Temple Terrace. He completed it on 1/6/04 and reported on that discharge summary that 2/20/03 was the [REDACTED] Mr. Marshall also completed a court ordered [REDACTED] September 2003. Mr. Marshall stated that he began attending [REDACTED] 1994.

**Drug/Alcohol Involvement:**

Mr. Marshall has a long history of [REDACTED] Mr. Marshall reported that he had been [REDACTED] Mr. Marshall reported that he has [REDACTED] but in an article that was published on August 2, 2007 by the St. Petersburg Times Mr. Marshall stated to the reporter that he had been [REDACTED] [REDACTED] During his exemption review, Mr. Marshall gave the

December 2006 date as his date of [REDACTED] Mr. Marshall stated that he [REDACTED] [REDACTED] He stated that he would work and sleep at the camp from Tuesday through Friday and that he would go home and [REDACTED]. He would then wake up Tuesday, go back to work and then do it all over again.

**Remorse / accept responsibility:**

Mr. Marshall inaccurately signed the Affidavit of Good Moral Character (AGMC). Mr. Marshall stated that he felt that he was a person of good and moral character and that he was allowed to sign where he did because he had passed the Level II screening for the Pinellas County School Board.

**References and other Documents:**

Letters of support for Mr. Marshall in granting his exemption were provided by approximately 50 parents of children that attend Mr. Marshall's summer camp, campers that are currently or have previously attended the camp and personal references. Most of the letters are from parents of children at the camp and they believe that Mr. Marshall is wonderful with the children there and that their kids love to attend camp there. Many of them stated that Mr. Marshall is the reason that the camp has been positive for their kids. There are also some letters from individual's that attend [REDACTED] with Mr. Marshall. The majority of the letters are from people that have known Mr. Marshall since he became employed by the City of St. Petersburg. All of the people present at the exemption hearing spoke on behalf of Mr. Marshall. Mr. Marshall discussed being involved in several neighbor associations in St. Petersburg aimed at helping build the communities. Several of the people present at the exemption review corroborated this.
