

Jeff Greene's Voice Mail to Jeff Benedict
6/7/2010

"Mr. Benedict, this is Jeff Greene calling you again. I don't know why you're not calling me, obviously you are trying to take our business from us, so I don't know what you're doing, but uh this all sounds very sleazy and fraudulent. We're gonna unfortunately file, go into bankruptcy today, to stop anymore of these take backs. I, I, we're telling all of the employees, to the hundreds of them that are impacted by uh some kind of ya know sleazy thing going on, we're trying to pay all of the rent, get everyone back to work in this bad economy and we've just told them to all call you. So you can tell (unintelligible) these people who aren't gonna have food on their table, kids aren't going to summer camp, kids aren't going to be able to uh have be able to survive, people aren't going to make their home payments. If this is making you feel good, then good for you. I've left my number with you many times. I found out about this last week. I immediately have tried to engage you and get this resolved. I offered to pay your legal fees and you have try to extort all kinds of money out of us. I don't know what you're doing here. Obviously, were gonna have no problem to. . . no, no, no choice now but to go into bankruptcy today, stop these evictions, and then when in the bankruptcy court, we're gonna obviously have to go after you for all of these damages I mean, unfortunately, this is where it's going, I mean I would have liked to resolved it. I have a feeling we're going to be in a multi-million dollar lawsuit against one another for the next several years.

So here's your last chance cause right now we're gonna we'll be in bankruptcy in the next couple of hours in Kansas 'cause that's where these corpora. . . companies are and we'll get a stay for any more of these uh evictions and uh in the meantime, you can deal with all of these employees whose lives you've, uh, you've destroyed. So, if you can sleep at night doing that to make a little bit make more money for you and Mr. MacLean, good for you, but I think it's absolutely horrible to do this to people.
