Evacuation category	Wind speed	Potential tide heights
■ A	74 to 95 mph	Up to 7 ft.
■ B	96 to 110 mph	Up to 12 ft.
■ C	111 to 130 mph	Up to 15 ft.
■ D	131 to 155 mph	Up to 20 ft.
■ E	Over 156 mph	Up to 24 ft.

If you live in a mobile home, you must evacuate regardless of location in the county.
